PORTO MONTENEGRO

Renaissance Summer House Buca , flowers' island with sacred monuments, Gornja Lastva, the old nucleus at an altitude of 300 m, the magnificent beach at Plavi Horizonti and the island Sv. Nikola are tourist destinations that should be visited in Tivat. In the city itself there is the natural marina Kaliman. Tivat is also the only place at the littoral with an airport. There is also a choice of cultural events.

But there is one of TOP place – you must visit – Porto Montenegro. Today, Tivat is one of the hottest tourist spots on the Mediterranean, because of Porto Montenegro – new modern marina for luxury yachts, with amazing settlement behind.

KOTOR

Located along one of the world's most beautiful bays is Kotor, a city of traders and famous sailors, with many stories to tell.

The Old City of Kotor is a well-preserved urbanisation typical of the middle Ages, built between the 12th and 14th century. Medieval architecture and numerous monuments of cultural heritage have made Kotor a UNESCO listed "World Natural and Historical Heritage Site". Through the entire city the buildings are criss-crossed with narrow streets and squares. The Cathedral of Saint Trifun a monument of Roman culture and one of the most recognisable symbols of the city, Prince's Palace from the 17th century and the Napoleon's Theatre from the 19th century are all treasures that are part of the rich heritage of Kotor. Carnivals and festivals are organised each year to give additional charm to this beautiful city of the Montenegrin littoral.



PERAST

Perast is situated opposite the Verige strait, at the foothill of the Kason hill. The objects found in the Spila cave, near Perast, testify to the early human presence in this area. The town was named after the Illyrian tribe Pirusta and it had a very rich history. This small baroque town reached its height of glory in the 17th and 18th centuries. At that time, Perast had a merchant fleet of around 100 ships. Its sailors were well-known for their skill and courage. Two small picturesque islands are located in front of Perast: St. George which is a natural island, and Our Lady of the Rock a man-made island. On the island of St. George there is a small church, erected in the 17th century and an old cemetery where most of the seafarers from Perast were buried. The island of Our Lady of the Rock was artificially built by piling stones over a sea rock. In Perast, there are many beautiful palaces that belonged to the famous seafarer families.





HERCEH NOVI

Herceg Novi is recognisable by the abundance of mimosa trees and its numerous flights of stairs. It is a 'city of the sun', thanks to the large number of sunny days all year round.

The centre of Herceg Novi is Stari Grad, decorated by buildings dating back to the epochs of Sahat – Kula (1667) and Kanli – Kula (1483). Fortress Spanjola (1538) and Fortress Forte Mare (1687) are only a part of the cultural heritage of this renowned town.

Full of thick greenery, Herceg Novi hides numerous kinds of tropical flowers. Towards the end of January the town becomes scented with the subtle fragrance of yellow and green mimosas and the festival of Mimosa is dedicated to this flower. During the summer months many festivals are organised to further enrich the tourist offer of this enchanted town.



BUDVA



Budva is the metropolis of Montenegrin tourism and the most desirable tourist destination thanks to the natural beauty, its bay islands and beaches, numerous of hotels and rich historic monuments. Budva Old Town lies on a small peninsula and represents a treasure of culture heritage. Crossed with narrow streets and squares are famous buildings, the Church Sv. Trojica, housing the tomb of the exquisite writer Stjepan Mitrov Ljubisa, the Churches of Sv. Ivan, Sv. Bogorodica and Sv. Sava. During the summer months it turns into a City Theatre with numerous local performances and shows from abroad. In the Old town you can also visit many shops, cafés, restaurants and galleries. It is among the most beautiful coasts in the world and its beauty will not leave you indifferent. Also, wide range of accommodation, from very affordable to exclusive and luxury. Budva is most visit place in Montenegro and the whole city is dedicated to provide best tourist offer.

SVETI STEFAN

The tiny island of Sveti Stefan is situated just off the Montenegrin coast. it's a luxury resort ready to meet your needs. The island itself is very small, connected to the mainland only by a narrow bridge, with the stone houses tightly packed together on top of the rocks. Guests who come here can stay in everything from individual rooms to entire villas with private pools and terraces, offering a magnificent view of the sea. The island is a perfect blend of rustic and elegant. If this isn't enough, Aman Sveti Stefan offers two pools open to all guests, a spa with an infinity pool, a gym and several restaurants. Many celebrities have visited the island, like Claudia Schiffer and Sylvester Stallone. Robert de Niro even opened a restaurant and when Sophia Loren visited Sveti Stefan she said: "It's just as if I have returned to town from the most beautiful fairy tale of my childhood". We're telling you to get there now and see it for yourself. In the immediate vicinity is also "Villa Milocer", once a royal holiday villa, today a luxury hotel situated in the beautiful and rich park, close to the "Queen's beach" – one of the most beautiful small beaches in the world.



ROSE



A lovely hamlet at the tip of Lustica peninsula, untouched Rose is a sweet spot to wile away an afternoon. With its old fishing village vibe, it's favoured by notable Montenegrins who keep holiday homes in its old waterfront buildings and in the hills above town. Ordering fresh fish, bowls of mussels, or grilled octopus with a bottle of local Krstac at one of Rose's seaside cafés is one of life's simple pleasures. One of Montenegro's oldest settlements, the local swimming platform is located at Forte Rose, an ancient Austro-Hungarian citadel that's now equipped with an al fresco summertime bar and a restaurant.

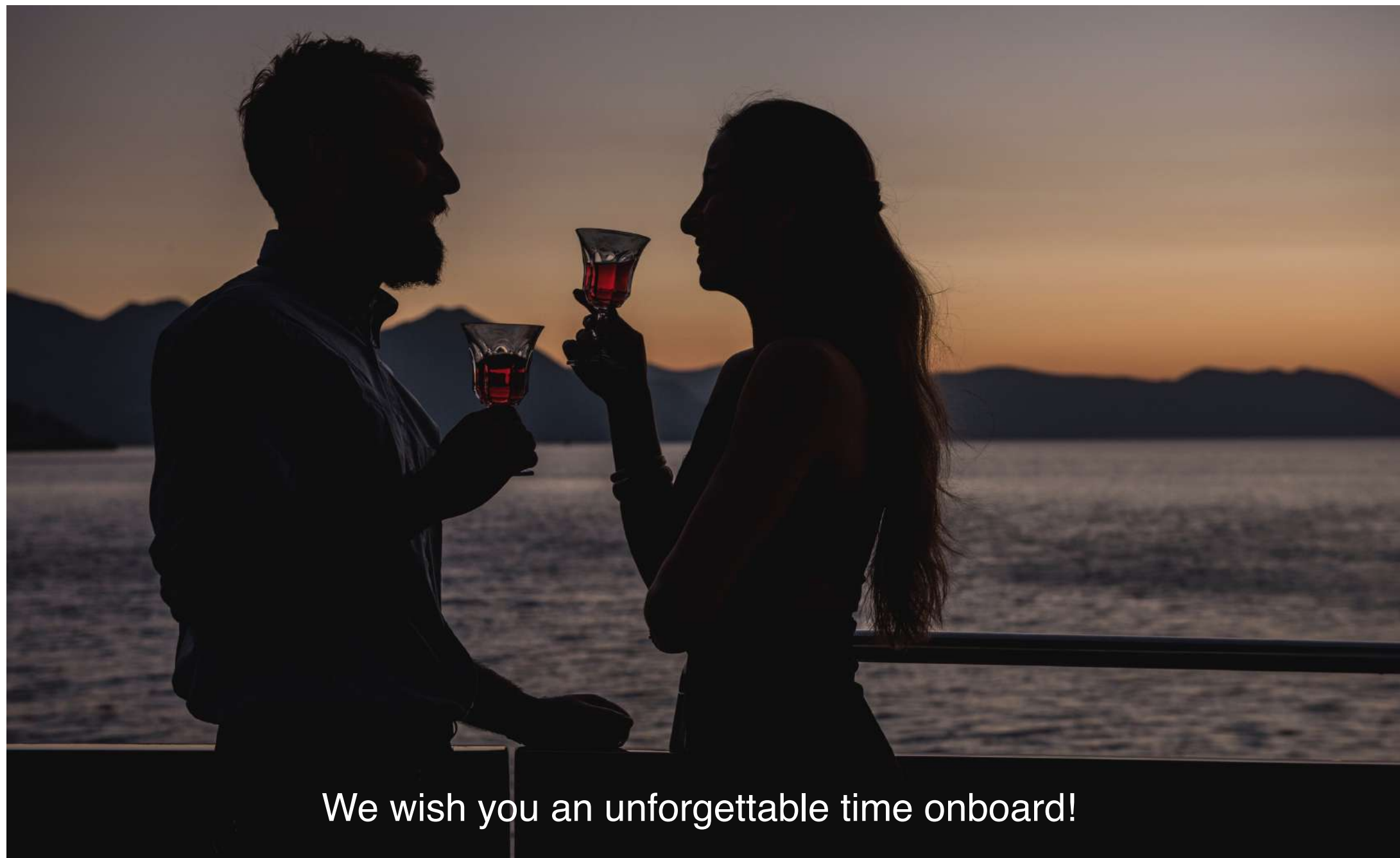
